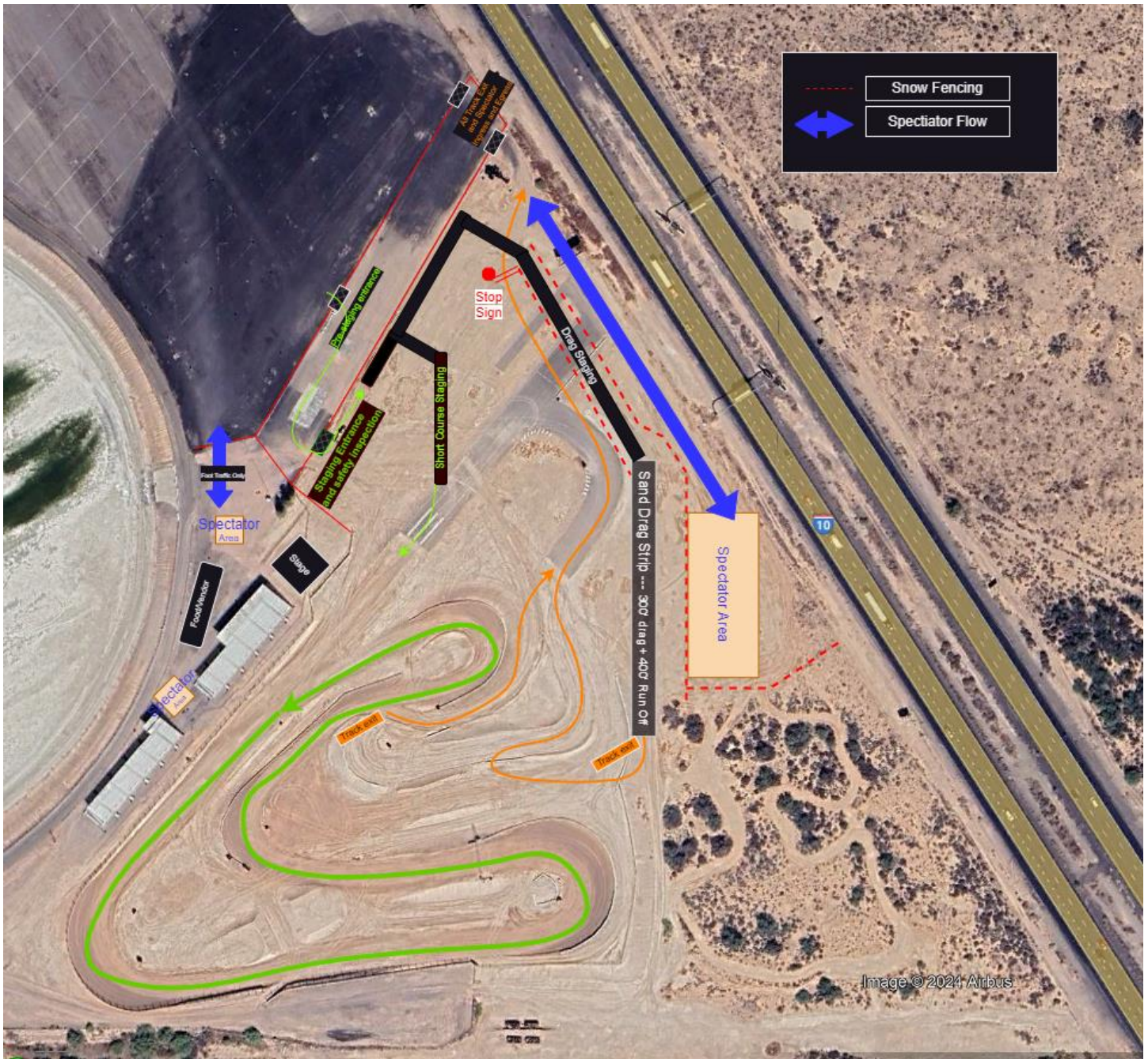




Event Map

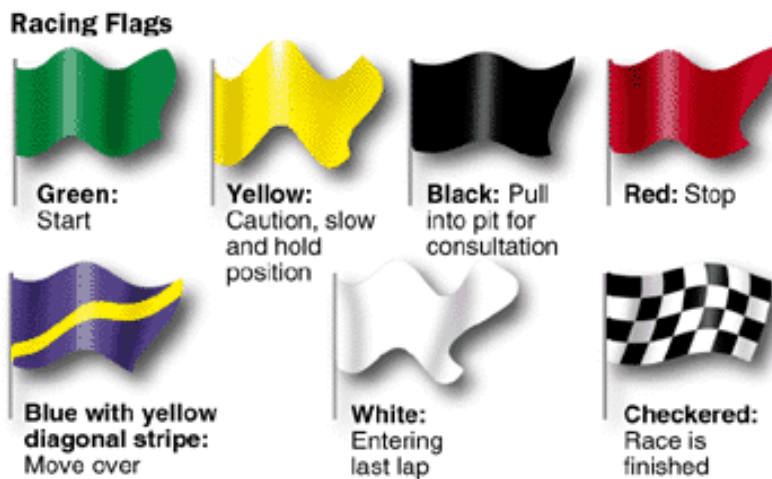




Rules of the Track and Schedule

Please read and follow all the rules of the track. **Your safety is our #1 Priority...**

1. All Drivers and passengers **must** show their wrist band at safety check in.
2. All Drivers and passengers **must** wear all required personal protective items listed below. (NO EXCEPTION)
 - a. Long Pants
 - b. Closed Toed Shoes
 - c. DOT Rated Helmet
 - d. Eye protection (helmet visor or goggles) NOTE -sun glasses are NOT eye protection
 - e. 4 Point (or more) Harness
3. All Vehicle occupants must always keep ALL body parts inside the vehicle. Failure to comply will be immediate removal from track.
4. All vehicles must follow all staging protocols. Familiarize yourself with the event map.
5. Follow all directions of track support staff.
6. Understand and follow flag conditions from **track support** and **flagging tower**. If the pace car pulls onto track stay behind pace car. If the pace car pulls off track at track exit you must follow him. If the pace car clears track rapidly you may proceed to run track once he is clear. Pace Car and Track Support vehicles will be presenting flashing yellow lights please maintain safe speed while pace vehicle is controlling track.





Rules of the Track and Schedule

Campers and Visitors – Please remember we are on tribal land. Respect the host property and all participants. Welcome to the CORR family...

1. No open fires. Propane heaters ONLY
2. Set up camp in a responsible manner. Utilize space appropriately and leave room for others
3. ABSOLUTLY NO PIT RIDING
4. No Drones
5. No Fireworks
6. No Fire Arms – Tribal laws are very strict
7. Maintain fire perimeter lanes. If you block a fire lane, you will be asked to move
8. All Campers and visitors must exit Firebird property no later than 11am Sunday morning
9. Clean up any trash. Please don't leave a mess behind. We would like to keep this going in the future

NOTE: If you are not in staging at the beginning of your class slot you may not be able to join the track mid-session. Track maintenance will be completed on a "as needed basis" and the track will be shut down momentarily for that purpose.

11:00am – 11:15am -- Youth (5yrs – 12yrs) 170cc through 250cc

11:15am – 11:30am -- Youth (12yrs – 16yrs) 800cc through 1000cc

11:30am – 11:45am -- Youth (5yrs – 12yrs) 170cc through 250cc

11:45am – 12:00pm -- Youth (12yrs – 16yrs) 800cc through 1000cc

Big Cars- Maximum 20 UTV's on track for each session. Each session will last approximately 10 to 15 mins

12:00pm – 4:30pm -- All UTV's Adults (18+) and CORR racers 16+

4:30pm – 5:00pm – Race Trucks only

5:00pm – 6:00pm Intermission

*****NOTE-** For Barrel and Long Jump events, participants must register for the event(s) no later than 5:00pm. No late entries will be accepted. Proceed to the Registration desk to sign up for either or both events. GREAT NEWS!!! Its no additional cost to participate.
